1 Wickham Water Meadows

Fareham Road PO17 5DE

The naturally formed water meadows cover approximately eight acres and form a rare and tranquil oasis in the middle of a town.

2 St Nicholas Church

Southwick Road, PO17 6HP

Dating back to 1120, this delightful brick and flint church is said to stand on the site of an earlier chapel, and sits on a very large, almost circular, sacred mound.

3 Meon Valley Trail

Discover a trail that leads you through English history. Once a railway line running from Fareham to Alton transporting local livestock and agricultural produce, the trail now spans 11 miles through picturesque countryside, from West Meon in the north to Wickham in the south.

4 Wickham Square

The magnificent Wickham Square is one of the largest in the country covering nearly two acres. On arrival, look up to take in the wonderfully erratic roofline. This gives you a glimpse of the historical context of this pretty town before you go on to take in its diverse tapestry of architecture at street level.

5 Forest of Bere

West Walk, Hundred Acres Road, PO17 6JD

The trail takes you in a loop, through the historic landscape of the Forest of Bere, which today supports an important range of wildlife.



6 Wickham Estate

Three Choirs are a wedding and functions venue holding special celebrations from weddings to birthday parties and corporate functions. They have a shop on site to purchase wines from their Hampshire and Gloucester vineyards.

History boards

Follow the notice boards around Wickham to discover its fascinating past, from Roman and medieval times to its 20th century development.

Highlights include the largest medieval square in the country, houses dating back to the late 1400s, a 900 year old church, and the mill with an American connection.

It is an Iron Age hill fort with Bronze Age burial mounds with spectacular views across the valley to Beacon Hill and down to the sea. It is a great place for stargazing!
